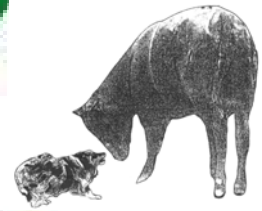

4 – 40 run trials Saturday and Sunday, Sept. 25th and 26th, 2010

WASC of GA reserves the right to make adjustments in number of runs. Limited to 40 runs cattle, sheep and ducks combined per trial on Saturday and Sunday.

Trials Each day - 1st TRIAL starts 8 a.m. 2nd TRIAL to run concurrently.

Handlers meeting 7:30 a.m. each day. Trial Starts immediately after. Run order, Cattle, Ducks, Sheep, per above when 1st trial cattle is finished, 2nd trial cattle will start, and 1st trial ducks will start, etc.

CLASSES: Advanced, Open, Started, Novice, and Junior

STOCK: SHEEP: 3-5 head Katahdin/Dorper

DUCKS: 5 head Khaki Campbell/Indian Runner Cross

CATTLE: 3-5 head Commercial Black Angus Beef Cattle

Entry Fees: Ducks \$25/run

Sheep \$35.00/run

Cattle \$40.00/run

Pre-entry will be accepted beginning Postmark date Monday, August 16, 2010. and close Postmark date Friday, September 3, 2010.

Late entries and/or day of trial entries, if available, add **\$10** per run. No hand delivery on pre-entries; No facsimile or Email entries; Entries must be postmarked; if using express mail and waive signature must be marked. An official waiting list will be kept - run order will be drawn prior to day of trial – Day of entries, if available will be added to end of draw in the order in which they are received. Returned check invalidates entry and will be charged a \$35 fee.

Trial will be run under ASCA rules and regulations. Entries must be on official ASCA entry forms:

- Please write clearly – include registration number or ASCA tracking number (if applicable, see below).
- Incorrect and/or missing information may invalidate entries – entry must be signed.
- Please include e-mail address on entry forms to receive confirmation of entry.

Other Breeds need a Tracking Number from ASCA to record score for ASCA titles.

Entries will not be refunded for any reason after the closing date of September 3, 2010

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be returned if the dog's entry is pulled or withdrawn. Entry fees will not be returned if the trial cannot be opened or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of Working ASA of GA. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the Trial Committee, ASCA, the Host, show veterinarian, Course Director, livestock provider, or stockdog judge.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions are allowed by owner/handler. Any change requests, including substitutions, must be submitted to the CD or trial secretary in writing no later than the evening before the trial. You may only substitute your runs with dogs you own or co-own, after the closing date is reached.

Bitches in season may be substituted but will run in order and must be crated when not competing.

MOVE-UPS: No charge for move-ups. All move-ups or changes *must* be handled by the course director, prior to the start of the trial, no exceptions.

Stock trials will run concurrently. Each class of stock for the first trial will be completed before the same class of stock for second trial begins. For example, cattle from the first trial will be complete before cattle for the second trial begins. Ducks for the first trial might be running at the same time as cattle for the second trial. Then the second duck trial might be running at the same time as the first sheep trial sheep. We make every effort to keep both arenas running efficiently and that requires your cooperation. If you need to know whether your first run qualified to move up for the second trial, please see the course director, not the judge.

Exhibitors are responsible for any injuries to livestock. Owners/Handler of dogs will be held responsible for all injuries to livestock during their runs. Replacement costs are: \$25.00 per duck, \$150 per sheep, and \$700 per cow unless posted otherwise at time of trial.

AWARDS: Saturday and Sunday each trial: Class placement ribbons 1st -4th and qualifying scores ribbons will be awarded. Other awards from our Classic sponsors for HIT for each class of stock each trial and special Jr. awards will be offered.

Special Classic Weekend Awards
Please mark on your entry form if you will be competing for these awards.

High Combined WTCH Aussie: Highest combined score from all 4 trials on all classes of stock to the Aussie that begins the trial with the WTCH title.

High Combined Non-WTCH Aussie: Highest combined score from all 4 trials on all classes of stock to the Aussie that begins the trials not having earned the WTCH title. Scores may be earned in the Open and/or Advanced divisions.

Most Promising Started Aussie: **Highest combined total of the top 2 scores from each class of stock from the Started division.

High Combined Other Breed: Highest combined score over all 4 trials from any division on all classes of stock.

****Note:** We use only the two highest started scores for each class of stock-- ducks, sheep and cattle, to compute the combined score. This provides the opportunity for dogs to move up to open after two qualifying runs if the handler wishes to do so. However, if the handler of a started Aussie wishes to compete for the High Combined Aussie non-WTCH award (instead of the Most Promising Started Aussie award), that intention must be declared before the start of the trial.

HOLD HARMLESS: The Trial Committee, Members of WASCOF GA, and the owners of the host facility, Raymond Quinn, Tony Padgett, Donna Padgett, Coosawattee Farm and its associates, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by any exhibitor, handler, dog, property, child or spectator. This trial is being held on private property. You understand by your attendance and/or entry that the Show/Trial Committee and Hosts have the right to refuse or excuse any entry or spectator for good cause. Good cause would be violation of the private property owners' rights or violation of the ASCA show rules.

EXHIBITOR / HANDLER RESPONSIBILITIES:

Dogs must be kept under control at all times meaning either on leash or crated when not competing. Owners and handlers are responsible for the actions of their dogs and are responsible for injury caused by their actions or that of their dog. Please pick up after your dog in all areas. No electrical and/or mechanical training devices will be permitted on the trial grounds. For the safety of your dogs and others all dogs must have current vaccinations against rabies, distemper/parvo; you are asked to bring a copy of the rabies certificate with you.

TRIAL SITE: Coosawattee Farm, 868 New Town Loop Rd, Calhoun, Georgia, GA 30701, tie tarps and pop-ups securely; pick up after your dog and all trash; no dumping on site; dress appropriately for inclement weather; wear appropriate foot wear for traction; use sunscreen; terrain can be slightly uneven – low river bottom terrain; actively grazed pastures; creek.

DIRECTIONS

- Exit South bound I-75 , Exit 315, HWY 156 RED BUD RD —
